

### A STUDENT-CENTERED PROGRAM MODEL



Reading Partners leverages a mix of traditional and innovative programs and partnerships to provide support to students, schools, and communities.

### BY THE NUMBERS

- 655** students participated in 12+ sessions of one-on-one tutoring (688 students participated in at least one session)
- 95%** of students identify as people of color
- 18,279** total tutoring sessions delivered (28 sessions per student on average)
- 33%** of sessions delivered online via Reading Partners Connects
- 887** community tutors
- 15** partner schools
- 12,954** books distributed to students through the "Take Reading with You" program

### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY IMPACT

- 100%** of principals report improved school-wide progress.\*
- 100%** of teachers report Reading Partners is valuable to their school.\*
- 88%** of volunteers are satisfied with their volunteer experience.\*
