Our mission is to help children become lifelong readers by empowering communities to provide individualized instruction with measurable results.

7,881	total tutoring sessions delivered (31 sessions per student on average)
369	community tutors
8	partner schools
5,555	books distributed to students through the "Take Reading with You" program
