### STUDENT GROWTH

#### All Reading Partners students

**83%** meeting or exceeding their primary end-of-year literacy growth goal

#### K-2 Reading Partners students

**88%** developing mastery of key foundational reading skills\* needed to read at grade level

\*We track growth in the key foundational literacy skills students need to become independent readers, such as alphabetic principle, phonics, and vocabulary.

### AN EVIDENCE-BASED PROGRAM THAT GETS RESULTS



Reading Partners leverages a mix of traditional and innovative programs and partnerships to provide support to students, schools, and communities.

### BY THE NUMBERS

<b>170</b>	students participated in 12+ sessions of one-on-one tutoring (192 students participated in at least one session)
<b>94%</b>	of students identify as people of color
<b>4,645</b>	total tutoring sessions delivered (27 sessions per student on average)
<b>33%</b>	of sessions delivered online via Reading Partners Connects
<b>246</b>	community tutors
<b>6</b>	partner schools and other community-based locations
<b>3,622</b>	books distributed to students through the "Take Reading with You" program

<b>83%</b>	of volunteers are satisfied with their volunteer experience.*
