During the school year

students participated in 12+

(368 students participated in at
least one session)

98% of students identify as people of color

total tutoring sessions delivered(29 sessions per student on average)

additional students reached through school-wide book fairs

489 community tutors

9 partner schools and other community-based locations

books distributed to students through the "Take Reading with You" program
