### A STUDENT-CENTERED PROGRAM MODEL



Reading Partners leverages a mix of traditional and innovative programs and partnerships to provide support to students, schools, and communities.

### BY THE NUMBERS

- 728** students participated in 12+ sessions of one-on-one tutoring (837 students participated in at least one session)
- 98%** of students identify as people of color
- 18,691** total tutoring sessions delivered (26 sessions per student on average)
- 23%** of sessions delivered online via Reading Partners Connects
- 595** community tutors
- 22** partner schools and other community-based locations
- 17,927** books distributed to students through the "Take Reading with You" program

### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY IMPACT

- 100%** of teachers report Reading Partners is valuable to their school.\*
- 83%** of volunteers are satisfied with their volunteer experience.\*
