Reading Partners collaborates with schools and communities to provide comprehensive literacy support to young students. Students in our tutoring program are referred by teachers and receive:

- ongoing assessments to help guide their individualized, data-informed instruction
- ✓ two evidence-based tutoring sessions per week
- culturally representative books at the appropriate reading level to help build their personal libraries We also provide a suite of family engagement literacy focused resources to support at-home learning.

CAP Tulsa recently recommitted to the vision that all children served would reach their full developmental potential by the end of third grade. Family Engagement

Powered by Reading Partners has helped ensure that families who participate in their alumni program, CAP Connect, as well as their ESL program, are equipped to support and advocate for their growing readers. In the first year of partnership, 19 CAP Connect families and 50 CAP ESL participants attended workshops, and 100% of participants rated the workshop they attended as excellent (75%) or good (25%).

Partnership spotlight



CommonBond is an organization in the CommonBond CommonNilles Twin Cities that provides wrap-around services to residents in their housing

communities. Knowing that literacy is a foundation for student success, they've partnered with Reading Partners to enhance their Study Buddy program focused on literacy and social emotional learning. Dedicated tutors from the Study Buddy program have been trained to implement Reading Partners Connects programming in each of their sessions with students. The youth leaders at six CommonBond communities have learned to manage the program and coach tutors toward student success. At the end of the year, 85% of students saw their literacy scores go up during the time in the program.
