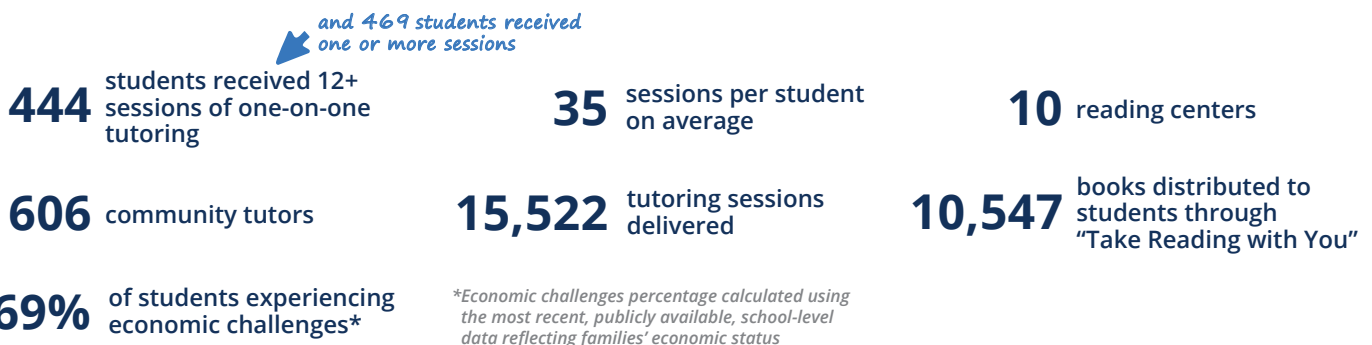
Minnesota: 2024-25



Reading Partners collaborates with schools and communities to provide comprehensive literacy support to young students, including:

- ★ two evidence-based tutoring sessions per week rooted in the science of reading and social-emotional learning.
- ★ ongoing assessments that help guide individualized, data-informed instruction for students.
- ★ representative books at the appropriate reading level to help students build personal libraries.
- ★ a suite of literacy-focused family engagement resources to support at-home learning.

Expanding access to literacy support through innovation & partnerships

Beyond the classroom, Reading Partners Minnesota gets the community involved in our literacy work. The Powered by Reading Partners model provides our partners with engaging, high-quality educational materials and extensive training to implement effective literacy tutoring. Furthermore, we collaborate with corporate partners to host book distributions events for our school partners.

Community partner spotlight



Hennepin County Library finished their second full year of partnership with Reading Partners. In this collaboration, the Hennepin County Library team is fully trained to lead tutoring using the Reading Partners Connects platform in-person at 8 different library branches after-school. Students and families make a commitment to attend the library at scheduled times to receive ongoing literacy tutoring from trained volunteers recruited by the library. Hennepin County Library is further expanding literacy tutoring in partnership with Reading Partners next year.
