Expanding literacy access beyond the classroom

Through partnerships and innovation, we meet students and families where they are: in libraries, recreation centers, youth organizations, and even at home. By 2028, our goal is to support 400,000 students and families annually.

In the 2025-26 school year alone, **177,119 students and families** were positively impacted through Reading Partners literacy programs in their communities.



Direct-impact tutoring

 **5,160** students received 12+ in-person or on-line sessions, and **5,677** students received at least one session

 **152,515** tutoring sessions delivered by **5,244** community tutors

 **100,941** books distributed to students through the "Take Reading with You" program

Student literacy gains

 **82%** of all students met or exceeded their individualized reading growth goals

 **88%** of K-2 students developed mastery of key foundational reading skills** needed to read at grade level
